Terms & Conditions

1. The candidates must possess the requisite qualification on or before the last date of the submission of online applications from the recognized University/Board.

2. Age as on 01.01.2016 (Category Wise)

- a) Candidates should not be below 18 years and above 37 years of age as on 01.01.2016
- b) The upper age limit is relax-able up to 45 years for all State/Central Government employees.
- c) The upper age limit is relax-able to the extent of 5 years i.e. up to 42 years for Scheduled Caste/Backward Classes of Punjab.
- d) Ex-Servicemen of Punjab Domicile shall be allowed to deduct the period of his service in the Armed Forces of Union from his actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for direct appointment to such a vacancy in the concerned service rules, by more than three years, he shall be deemed to satisfy the conditions regarding age limit.
- e) The upper age limit is relax-able to the extent of 10 years i.e. up to 47 years for Physically Handicapped candidates of Punjab.

3. Nationality:

A Candidate shall be a

- i. Citizen of India; or
- ii. Citizen of Nepal; or
- iii. Subject of Bhutan; or
- iv. Tibetan refugee who came over to India before 1st January, 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India; or
- v. Person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka and East African countries of Kenya, Uganda and United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar) Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India;

Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (ii), (iii), (iv) and (v) shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been given by the Government of Punjab in the Department of Home Affairs and Justice.

4. Knowledge of Punjabi

Candidate should have passed Matriculation examination with Punjabi as one of the subject or its equivalent examination from recognized institution or board on or before the last date of the submission of online applications.

6. Mode of Selection

Selection will be made purely on the basis of merit in the written test to be conducted by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

Candidates, who will score minimum 33% marks in the written test, will only be declared as eligible and the candidates who will score less than 33% marks in the written test will be declared as ineligible.

Merely appearing in the written test will not entitle the candidates for the right to selection unless they fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria and other terms and conditions of the advertisement. Selection will be on the inter-merit of the written test subject to the reservation prescribed by the Government.

- b) In case qualify candidates obtain equal marks in the written examination, then preference will be given to the candidate who is older in age.
- c) No extra weightage shall be admissible to the candidates possessing higher qualification or experience.
- d) Experience of only those reputed hospitals/institutions will be considered, which fulfill the following conditions:-

- i) Hospital/institution having well equipped laboratory.
 - ii) Hospital/institution having full time Pathologist/Microbiologist.
 - iii) Hospital/institution in which minimum 20 tests of different type are done daily.
- e) The candidates who have possessed their professional qualifications through Distance Education Mode will not be considered for this post as per the guidelines issued by the "AICTE"
- f) No TA/DA will be payable for appearing in written examination/document checking
- g) Department reserves the rights to change or cancel the selection process at any stage.

7. Other important instructions

- a) The category once filled will not be allowed to be changed.
- b) To take benefit of reservation, the reservation certificates/testimonials must be issued by the competent authority on or before the last date of submission of applications. No extra time will be given for production of these documents.
- c) It will be the responsibility of the applicant to verify that the University/Institution from which he has acquired the qualification is duly

approved by the competent authority in the said stream on the date he has acquired the qualification. In the event that the department seeks any information in this regard and the candidate is not able to in-time produce the specified documents, his candidature shall be rejected without assigning any further opportunity. Such applicants may however be allowed to appear in the written test provisionally and the entire risk shall be borne by the concerned candidate.

- d) The venue, date and time of counseling of the candidates in merit will be available on the website www.pbhealth.gov.in, candidates will not be informed individually about the result and counseling schedule.
